During 2009, Kids In the Middle.....

Helped 1,311 children and their families through its Agency Based, School Based and Court Based programs

By Site.....

Agency Based Services at our Kirkwood Office

- **334 families** including **411 children** were seen at our Kirkwood office
- **209 children** participated in 3,320 units of group therapy
- **113 children** participated in 887 individual therapy sessions
- **27 parents** participated in 178 individual therapy sessions
- **69 parents** participated in 144 parent group sessions
- **39 families** participated in 188 family therapy sessions
- **42 parents** came to KITM for consultations.
- **73 parents** participated in 215 Co-Parenting Counseling sessions

Counseling Services at Area Schools

- **805 children** received 7,710 units of group and individual therapy through our School Outreach Counseling Program by KITM therapists working in local schools.

Workshops at the 22nd Judicial Circuit Court, Family Court

- **330 parents** attended mandated parent education workshops.
- **95 children** attended optional children's workshops.

Professional Training

- Kids In the Middle provided clinical field placements at our Kirkwood and School sites for 12 master's level students in local university social work and counseling graduate programs.
